## Club finances

We were fortunate to start the Lock-down with a healthy current account bank balance: \$7900 as at the end of March. While we are closed the club still has to pay quarterly levies to NZ Bridge, Insurance, website maintenance and also power & phone/internet. These have reduced our bank balance to only \$600 today.
