Hello Everyone

The AGM was held on Friday 20th September attended by 79 members. After my President's report on the club's year Bridget gave the treasurer's report. Cath announced the result of the vote for start time for afternoon sessions. Of the 123 votes cast 90 voted to stay at the 1pm start that we have trialled this year, so this will continue in 2025. Caroline, as the incoming President, led the rest of the meeting where the motions were discussed and voted on. Motions that were carried were the increase of subs by \$10 and table money to \$5 from January 2025, and that players in teams competitions would play with each member of the team each week The motion requesting social bridge on a Monday morning was removed by an amendment from the floor as it is against the rules set down by NZ Bridge which requires all sessions to allocate Masterpoints. The amendment was passed. The motion to run Wednesday's session as a morning session was defeated. The meeting ended at 1:10 pm before the bridge session began. As the meeting ran late we were unable to have general business.
