Junior Bridge on Tuesdays – open to juniors at all levels. Please be seated by 6.45pm. Finishes approx. 9.30pm. No partner needed



## For your information:


1) When playing a series which allows a substitute for a session but enables you to remain in the competition can you please write your subs











name on the sheet up by the scorer's desk so that they can ensure it has been recorded correctly.

2) A Director should be called to the table when an infringement/ query/ illegal bid has occurred. This is not a bad thing! This is not a punishment! This is to sort the matter according to the rules of the game. However, correct protocol should be followed. One person- the one who considers there is an issue should explain clearly the problem, but not all 4 at the table. The director should be able to ask questions to clarify if needed and give a directive. The partner of the infringer should not be asking questions at this time, nor should both of the opposition be hassling the director. Play will resume with the decision, so as not to hold up play. If the partnership wishes for further information about the decision they can discuss it with the director after the session. This should be the first call in an effort to understand/accept the ruling. If still not satisfied, then the go - to- advisor on play can become involved.
